The Outings

The number of outings will be dependent on weather and the itinerary's landing points. Each outing will be up to three hours in duration. Participants will be led through a wide variety of snowshoeing expeditions designed for all abilities, by our expert guides who will provide all the instructions needed.

Clothing and Equipment

Snowshoes and ski poles for all participants will be provided. Bring clothing that is suitable for the changeable weather of the polar regions: thermal underwear, breathable jacket, thick socks, sunglasses and backpack are recommended.

Pre-requisites to participate

The minimum age for this activity is 14. No previous experience is required. Participants should have an average level of fitness; those who enjoy hiking trails and walking will have enough fitness to enjoy this activity.



Group Capacity

Group capacity will depend on the itinerary you are on.

Safety Precautions
