This is an incredible opportunity to experience the sights and sounds of being in the Antarctic elements at night. Witness dramatic light changes and the clamor of scurrying penguins on a true outdoor adventure.

ADDITIONAL DETAILS

THE PROGRAMME

The camping will begin after your onboard evening meal is served. Participants will be accompanied to the campsite by a professional guide(s) who will provide detailed information and instructions. You will return to the vessel approximately one hour before breakfast the following morning. The time spent ashore will not usually exceed 10 hours.

Depending on the ship you have the option of sleeping under the stars.

GROUP CAPACITY

Antarctica Camping is limited to between 40 and 60 participants per voyage. Children between 12 and 18 years of age are allowed to participate only accompanied by a parent or guardian.

CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

Participants need to get prepared for potentially adverse conditions : hat, gloves, extra thick socks, windproof, waterproof parka and pants are a necessity. Comfortable tents, insulating mats, warm sleeping bags and portable toilet facilities will be provided by the staff.

PRE-REQUISITES TO PARTICIPATE

Previous camping experience is not necessary to participate but you must be mobile and in good health to avoid exposing yourself to an undue level of risk. A signed Liability Waiver Form and travel/medical insurance are required for participation.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Safety is the top priority during Antarctic camping excursions. Camping guides will have emergency equipment. Safety measures and emergency procedures will be in place and communication with the ship will be maintained throughout the excursion. Please be aware that camping in Antarctica takes place away from the ship for an extended period of time.

Camping is dependent on weather and ice conditions.
