### Pregnancy Information and Waiver

We are thrilled for you and wish you the best. As such our primary concern is for your health and safety, and that of your child.

Due to safety reasons, a cruise is only possible for pregnant women until the 24th week of pregnancy.

The Polar Regions can be some of the most remote areas on earth, and medical capabilities on board are limited. Our facility is a first aid clinic, not a full functioning medical site. There are no on-board OB/GYN facilities

Additionally, all carriers involved (airlines, ship owners, bus companies, hotels, etc.) have their own policies that may take effect.

Women who will be in weeks 13 through 24 throughout the entire voyage, and who have been cleared by their doctors are welcome, but must be aware of the limited medical facilities available during the voyage. Please take these precautions seriously, and please advise your doctor accordingly.

If you or your doctor has any questions at all, please feel free to discuss this directly with us and we can arrange for communication between our medical director and your doctor.
