INTRODUCTION

An unparalled 7-day exploration aboard Isabella II. Your itinerary begins on San CristÃ³bal Island and Puerto Baquerizo Moreno, the capital of the GalÃipagos Province. Visit Cerro Colorado, breeding centre of the islands' famous giant tortoises amid a fantastic deciduous forest. Sail north toto the sunken caldera of Genovesa Island, a privileged place to visit amid thousands of marine birds. Explore Puerto Egas, a great place to see land and marine birds amid a landscape of tuff-stone layers and lava flows. Visit Punta Espinoza with its amazing combination of barrenness and abundant wildlife. At Tagus Cove, an uphill hike takes you to the rim of Darwin Crater and some lovely views. Continue the exploration of Isabela Island, home to colourful GalÃipagos land iguanas and green sea turtles. Visit RÃibida Island and its large colony of sea lions, marine iguanas, mockingbirds, yellow warblers and several species of Darwin's finches. Wherever you sail, the Isabela II will ensure your GalÃipagos experience is truly memorable.

An intimate yacht experience awaits those on board the Isabela II, as it takes you throughout the untamed wilderness of the Galapagos Islands. Admiring the colourful multitudes of marine life from the glass-bottom boat, kayaking through the turquoise waters and relaxing in the on-board jacuzzi are just some of the incredible experiences that you can choose to make the most of your adventure whilst cruising through this equatorial wildlife haven.

The Yacht Isabela II offers only a few numbers of cabins, that will make you feel convivial whilst on board as crew take care of your maximum comfort. Let yourself taste delicious meals and make full use of all on board facilities including; a fitness room, jacuzzi, outside deck and bar.
