PERU - DISCOVER LIMA

DAY 1: Lima

Lima, the capital of Peru, sits on the country's arid Pacific coast. Founded in 1535, its colonial centre is well preserved, but today Lima is a bustling metropolis and one of South America's largest cities. The city is home to the various museums including the Museo Larco that houses a collection of pre-Columbian art and the Museo de la Nación, tracing the history of Peru's ancient civilizations. Lima is known as the "gastronomical capital of the Americas", encompassing specialties from ceviche and traditional coastal cooking to refined global fare. It even boasts several of the top restaurants in the world.



DAY 2: Lima City Tour & Larco Museum with Lunch

This morning you will be collected from your hotel to enjoy a complete city tour of Lima. First you will visit the Larco Herrera Museum and the National Museum of Archaeology and Anthropology. Have lunch in Miraflores. Afterwards, visit the modern district of San Isidro and Miraflores, where you will have a view of the Pacific Ocean from the Parque del Amor (Love Park), then you will continue with your tour of the "City of Kings" which begins in the downtown colonial district. Visit Plaza de Armas where you will see the Government Palace, the Cathedral, and the XVII century San Francisco Church the greatest monumental complex of Colonial Art in America and Cultural Heritage of Humanity and catacombs (a World Heritage Site). This is a chance to appreciate Lima's magnificent Colonial architecture as well as vignettes of its pre-Colombian past. On completion of this tour, you will be taken to your hotel. Please note this is a private tour. Lunch is included. This tour operates daily except Mondays.



DAY 3: Lima Pachacamac Museum

Today you will visit the sacred Pachacamac. An archaeological site located 31 kilometres from Lima it is made up of pyramids and temples which date back to 200 - 300 BC. Wander through the grounds and marvel at the Sun God shrine and the Palace of the Chosen Women before visiting the site museum to view the ceramics, textiles and idols found in the original temple of Pachacamac. Breakfast included.
