DAY 1: Reserva Amazonica Day One

Upon arrival to Puerto Maldonado you will be welcomed at the Butterfly House. Transfer to the pier for a 45 minute boat ride to arrive at Inkaterra Reserva Amazonica. Enjoy the Trail System adventure and the Twilight River excursion or, if you prefer, the nature presentation at the Eco Center with cocktails available to all. After dinner, you will overnight in your cabin.

Since 2006, we have been working with Kiva (a well-known Non-Governmental Organisation), providing hundreds of loans to local businesses all over South America.

- 5) Chimu Adventures' offices also take a number of sustainability measures including carbon offsets for company vehicles and most staff travel. Chimu Adventure's internal processes are also structured to create a paperless office and to reduce waste. There are also internal programmes to help staff minimise their carbon footprint such as our staff bike purchase assistance plan which encourages office staff to commute to work via bicycle. Currently almost half of our office based staff commute to work via bicycle.
