

DAY 2: Hike la Veronica

Explora Valle Sagrado offers a diverse menu of explorations, either on foot, by van, or bike. From traditional towns barely touched by the force of globalization to ancient ruins perfectly preserved from the passing of time, and lagoons at the foot of snow-covered mountains. All the explorations are led by competent and bilingual guides from the Explora Guide School and consist of groups of eight travelers with the option of different geographical and fitness levels. Additionally, there are half-day tours and full-day explorations available to discover the area. *Note: The itinerary detailed below does not include a visit to Machu Picchu. We encourage you to contact your booking agent to arrange a visit to Machu Picchu during your stay. Please be aware that an additional cost will apply, and it must be prebooked as it is subject to availability. Today, we embark on an enchanting hike to La Verónica, a journey that unfolds the ever-shifting beauty of the Andean region. Our adventure begins with a hearty breakfast at the lodge, preparing us for a day of exploration in this pristine wilderness. Nestled within a dedicated reserve, this trail plays a vital role in safeguarding pristine forests and providing sanctuary for endangered bird species. Our hike offers a rich tapestry of sensory encounters, each season imparting its distinct allure. In the dry season, we follow this path to behold the magnificent spectacle of snow-capped Mount Verónica and the surrounding peaks. The vistas that greet us on this journey reveal the majestic splendor of these snow-dusted summits. Keep an eye out for sightings of the Royal Cinclodes, a rare and treasured bird species that inhabits this region. In the rainy season, the landscape undergoes a significant change. Mosscovered cushions, intricate lichen formations, and glistening fungi adorn the hillside, providing a captivating sight. This hike offers a profound connection with the evolving seasons and the natural world, whether in the presence of snowcapped peaks or amid the subtleties of the hillside's ecosystem.







DAY 3: Lamay Community visit

Our day begins with a journey to the picturesque valley of Lamay, where we will engage in an immersive community visit to the charming village of Huayllafara. As we make our way to this vibrant community, we'll pause en route for a comprehensive briefing on the ongoing conservation projects that are helping to preserve the rich natural heritage of the region. Upon reaching the starting point of our hike, we step into a world where traditions, culture, and agriculture converge. In Huayllafara, we'll have the unique opportunity to participate in farm work, guided by the rhythms of the Andean calendar. This hands-on experience will introduce us to the cultivation of various local plants and crops, offering valuable insights into the agricultural practices deeply rooted in this community's heritage. During our visit, we will connect with the local residents, who will generously share their knowledge of farming tools and techniques passed down through generations. This exchange allows us to gain a deeper appreciation for the interplay between tradition and modernity in the daily lives of the Huayllafara community members. Our journey into the heart of Huavllafara culminates in a delightful lunch prepared by the community using locally sourced produce. This meal offers a true taste of the region's culinary heritage, showcasing the flavors and ingredients that define Andean culture. Note: As an alternative to the community visit in Lamay, today you have the option to embark on a full-day excursion to explore Machu Picchu. Please be aware that additional costs may apply.




