Highlights Include:

Punta del Inca Hike- Take a van to GuatÃn, a grazing area and junction point of the Puritama and Purifica rivers, and source of the Vilama River. There, walk along a canyon known as the Valley of the Cacti due to the existence of giant cacti. Cut cross the canyon crossing the river several times and descending along different waterfalls.

Tambo Bike Ride - Bike ride to the Catarpe Valley. Ride up to Cuchabrache, through an old road that crosses the Salt Ridge. Ride through plaster and crystallized salt creeks. This exploration includes seeing part of the local culture and petroglyphs, as well as the San Isidro chapel.

Cyebca del Salar - Leave in a van to Toconao, located to the south of San Pedro de Atacama. Walk to the village square and then through an area of vegetable gardens.

Finally, take a van to the Chaxa Lagoon, located in the Los Flamencos National Reserve, an ideal place for bird watching within Atacama's Salt Flat.

Cucuter - Horseback ride to the Moon Valley, explore its clay grounds, and see landscapes that seem to be from another world. Afterwards, go for lunch to the ayllu in Cúcuter, an oasis whose colors contrast with the desert landscape and where the whitish colors of Atacama salt flat begin to appear.

Our exquisite lodge nestled in the captivating oasis of San Pedro de Atacama, located in the Ayllu de Larache, a place steeped in the rich history of ancient Atacameño families. DAY 3: Exploring the Atacama Desert

Embark on an early morning expedition to the awe-inspiring Tatio Geysers, situated 90 km Northwest of our location at a staggering altitude of 4,300 meters above sea level. Witness the mesmerizing spectacle as over 100 geysers erupt, shooting water and steam up to an astounding height of 50 meters. On the return journey, descend through a picturesque landscape adorned with the presence of guanacos, vicuñas, elegant flamingo-like birds, and playful rodents. After savoring a delightful outdoor breakfast, you have the option to indulge in the soothing thermal waters of the Puritama Hot Springs, providing a blissful retreat for relaxation and rejuvenation. In the afternoon, traverse the striking Cordillera de la Sal, the Salt Mountain Range, to reach the renowned Valle de la Luna, the Valley of the Moon. Just 19 km from San Pedro de Atacama, this extraordinary valley presents a lunar-like landscape adorned with small yet jagged hills sculpted by the relentless forces of wind. Visit during the late afternoon, as the setting sun bathes the valley in a mesmerizing palette of colors, accentuating its ethereal beauty.
