# **INTRODUCTION**

Enjoy 16 days on board the Greg Mortimer exploring Franz Josef Land and all it has to offer. Franz Josef Land is an archipelago of spellbinding wonder and indescribable beauty. A land where natural beauty is encapsulated through fierce highlights of magnificent glaciers and snow capped peaks, where jagged mountains join with rolling tundra. A land where polar bears roam and walrus and wales dance in the icy waters off shore. This place is truly unique wonder.

# **ITINERARY**

DAY 1: Embarkation in Kirkenes

Arrive in Kirkenes, Norway, located on the border with Russia. Join a pre-arranged half day excursion or activity prior to boarding the Greg Mortimer late afternoon. Airport transfers will be included if arriving on preferred flights into Kirkenes. You'll have time to settle into your cabin before our important briefings. Sail the scenic Bokfjord to reach the Barents Sea on our way to Murmansk in neighbouring Russia.





#### DAY 2: Murmansk

After sailing overnight into Russia, we stop in Murmansk, to undergo formalities to enter Russia. During clearance procedures, we may go on a city of Murmansk visiting the monument to the soldier of WW2 and also the first nuclear icebreaker Lenin.

# DAY 3: At Sea - Day 3 - 4

Over the next two days at sea, enjoy informative and entertaining lectures from our expert expedition team including naturalists, historians and geologists. Take this time to also familiarise yourself with your crew and fellow passengers.



## DAY 5: Novaya Zemlya

Novaya Zemlya archipelago was once an important nuclear research site during the cold war, and today only a few places in the north are accessible to visitors. These islands offer stunning rugged Arctic landscapes - enormous extinct volcanoes, jagged cliffs and the most isolated mountain range in the Baltic Sea. For wildlife lovers, Novaya Zemlya boasts a great variety of flora and fauna, many of which are on the brink of extinction. You may get a chance to see a massive walrus rookery, various species of whale, and the Novaya Zemlya reindeer. If we're very lucky we may also see polar bear, and the ones found at Novaya Zemlya are considered to be a genetically unique sub-species.



## DAY 6: At Sea

Use this time to rest and relax on board. Enjoy more lectures from your expedition team in preparation for your arrival to Franz Josef Land.





DAY 7: Franz Josef Land Exploration - Day 7 - 13

Franz Josef Land is a stark yet beautiful world of glaciers, mosses and lichens. Approximately five million sea birds nest on the archipelago every year, with the thick-billed guillemot accounting for approximately 20%. Other seabirds such as fulmar, kittiwake, Brünnich's guillemot, black guillemot and little auk are common throughout the archipelago. On the flat tundra, nest other species such as: common eider, purple sandpiper, Arctic skua, glaucous gull, ivory gull, Arctic tern and snow bunting. Franz Josef Land is home to two Arctic giants - the Polar bear and the walrus. There is also a population of Arctic fox, which typically have their territories near seabird habitats. The waters of Franz Josef Land are visited by whales, including humpback, bowhead, narwhal, and white beluga whale. Walrus, ringed seals, bearded seals and an amazing species of mammals, choose Franz Josef Land and the water areas around it as their home. Depending on weather and natural conditions, you may visit locations such as Bell and Mabel Island, Hooker island, Cape Norway and Prince Rudolf island.

DAY 14: Return Along Barents Sea - Day 14 - 15

The return crossing of the Barents Sea offers some good opportunities to encounter whales, perhaps the elusive bowhead whale if you're lucky, and certainly plenty of opportunities to photograph sea birds.

Arrive in Murmansk in the morning, farewell your expedition team, crew and fellow expeditioners as you all continue our onward journeys, hopefully with a newfound sense of the immense power of nature. A transfer to downtown Murmansk or the airport is included in the cost of the voyage.
