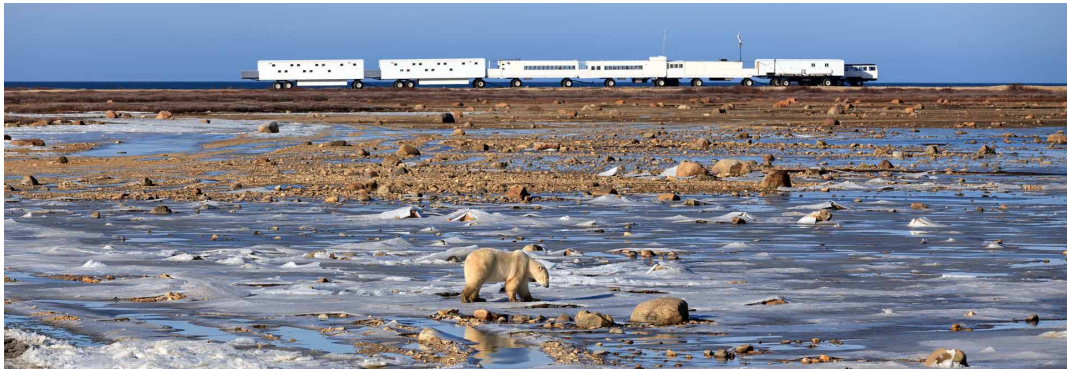


THE ARCTIC - TOWN & POLAR BEARS | TUNDRA BUGGY LODGE

This immersive Churchill Wildlife Management Area adventure combines Indigenous cultural experiences, expert interpretation, and multiple days exploring prime polar bear habitat aboard specially designed Tundra Buggies. Guests can learn about the region's wildlife, history, and conservation efforts while discovering why Churchill is known as the Polar Bear Capital of the World.

Spend your days searching for polar bears, arctic foxes, ptarmigan, and other subarctic wildlife while travelling across the tundra with experienced guides. With exceptional wildlife-viewing and photography opportunities throughout the journey, this itinerary offers an unforgettable opportunity to experience Canada's North and witness polar bears in their natural environment.

Sleeping On The Tundra In One-Of-A-Kind Accommodation Where Polar Bears Roam

Spend your nights in the heart of polar bear country at the unique Tundra Buggy Lodge. Located at Polar Bear Point within the Churchill Wildlife Management Area, the lodge allows guests to stay where the wildlife action happens, rather than travelling back and forth from town. Large viewing windows provide opportunities to watch polar bears and other wildlife passing by, while the remote tundra setting creates a truly immersive Arctic experience.

With comfortable cabin-style accommodation and all-inclusive hospitality, guests can relax in the middle of one of Canada's most important wildlife habitats. From sunrise to

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sunset, and even after dark, the lodge offers continual opportunities to connect with the Arctic wilderness, including the chance to spot polar bears right outside your window. The sleeping quarters consist of 10 upper and 10 lower berths, each featuring a standard twin-sized mattress (190 cm x 98 cm / 74.5 in x 38.5 in), a reading light, a personal window for wildlife viewing, and four 110-volt electrical outlets for charging devices. A sound-dampening curtain provides privacy by separating the berths from the aisle. In addition, each 20-person accommodation unit has three bathrooms, two of which are equipped with showers.

Thanadelthur Lounge

The Thanadelthur Lounge serves as the social heart of the Buggy Lodge, providing a welcoming space to unwind after a day on the tundra. This shared gathering space creates a friendly expedition atmosphere where guests can enjoy expert presentations, discuss wildlife sightings, and share stories from the day's adventures.

From Tundra To Table

Dining is an important part of the Tundra Buggy Lodge experience, with chef-prepared meals showcasing regional flavours and locally inspired ingredients. Guests can enjoy hearty breakfasts, lunches and multi-course dinners while sharing stories from the day's wildlife encounters, adding a memorable culinary element to their time in polar bear country.

First Ever Electric Vehicle Tundra Buggy- Reducing Noise Pollution For More Immersive Wildlife Viewing

The Electric Vehicle Tundra Buggy represents the next generation of Arctic wildlife exploration, combining innovative technology with a commitment to more sustainable travel. Its quieter operation allows guests to enjoy a comfortable, more immersive wildlife-viewing experience while helping reduce the environmental impact of exploring one of Canada's most sensitive ecosystems.

ITINERARY

DAY 1: Arrive Winnipeg

Upon arrival in Winnipeg, check in to your conveniently located airport hotel. Later, join a welcome reception hosted by a Frontiers North Interpretive Guide, who will introduce you to the journey ahead. Overnight at your hotel in Winnipeg.



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DAY 2: Fly to Churchill

This morning, take an early flight to Churchill, where you will set out on a guided tour of the town and surrounding area. Visit the Itsanitag Museum and enjoy a cultural presentation led by a local Indigenous Churchill resident. Overnight at your hotel in Churchill.



DAY 3: Dog Sledding & Tundra Buggy Lodge

Begin the day with an exciting dog-sledding experience and interpretive program, followed by a visit to the Parks Canada Visitor Centre. In the afternoon, travel across the tundra aboard a Tundra Buggy® to the Tundra Buggy Lodge, where you will spend the night.



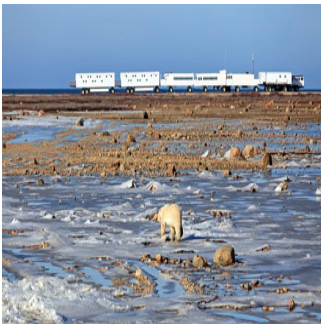
DAY 4: Tundra Buggy Adventures

Spend a full day exploring the vast Churchill Wildlife Management Area aboard a specially designed Tundra Buggy®. As you travel across the remote Arctic landscape, keep watch for polar bears and other northern wildlife while your guide shares insights into the region’s unique ecosystem. Return to the Tundra Buggy Lodge for another memorable overnight stay in the heart of the tundra.



DAY 6: Final Tundra Buggy Adventures

Enjoy another full day exploring the Churchill Wildlife Management Area aboard a Tundra Buggy®, with further opportunities to observe polar bears and other Arctic wildlife in their natural habitat. In the evening, fly back to Winnipeg and check in to your hotel for the night.

Enjoy another morning in Winnipeg before continuing your onward journey at your leisure.
